Mina Ayad is a girl in her late 20s. She is darker toned, tall, has short, blunt cut hair and green eyes. She doesn't carry gear on her, but she wears a charmed diamond-shaped necklace that keeps her from turning into a siren. One major part of her character is that she (and her whole family) is a family of sirens, and they choose to live on land due to polluted oceans/lakes. They all wear a similar necklace. Her family owns a seafood restaurant, which is their main source of income. She lives with her two parents and her brother. She is both physically strong and mentally strong and would do anything for her family. Her strength is reflected in her style – she is typically seen wearing combat boots and jeans, regardless of the setting.

Social

Mina is an introvert. She speaks when she needs to be and converses with people confidently, but she doesn't speak if she doesn't have to. If given the opportunity, she would listen to people speak and follow the conversation, rather than contributing to the conversation herself. In her universe, she would be an outsider, simply another character in the story, with a narrator existing to help the audience understand things.

She is of lower status, seeing as how her and her family own a seafood restaurant, and in the ocean as sirens, her family is middle class, which gave them the ability/authority to leave the ocean. She grows to have a friend (other main character) but has no other close friends before that point. Her family friends consist of other sirens her family knew who moved onto land, but she's not particularly close with them. She doesn't know many people from the town and spends most of her time with her family.





Future

Mina has spent most of her life with her family, adjusting to life on land and helping with the restaurant (and society). Because of this, she is dedicated to her family and the restaurant, and often ignores the part of herself that wants to live her own life.

She has a side hobby/business of making authentic jewelry from what she finds in the ocean and selling it to jewelers in her area. The motivation for this business is to use the money for her future. If she had a way to ensure her family would be safe, the first thing she'd do would be to travel to other areas in the world, both underwater, and on land to meet other sirens and people of the world.

After being discovered by someone on land (other main character), she has *character development* and learns how to live her own life.
